



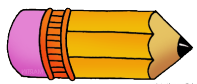

In Primary Four our work is now presented in topic form to tie all areas of learning together as much as possible.

This leaflet outlines what we will be covering in January / February in Numeracy and Literacy and through the theme of **World War Two** so that home learning can be organised to support your child if you wish.

Please Note: - *Not all aspects of each subject are included in this document and all children work at different levels of ability.*

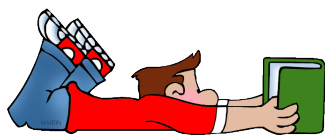
Numeracy

Number - Addition and subtraction of HTU (exchanging), introduction of multiplication (x2, x10 and x5), extending the concept of fractions.

Time and Measure- Telling the time in five minute intervals (up to half past). Analogue and digital. Understand and discuss the days and months in each year, discuss important dates in the calendar.



Shape & Space - Explore 3D shape properties. Investigate quarter turns, half turns and quarter turns.



Literacy

Sentence Work - Continue to revise capital letters, full stops, question marks, commas and exclamation marks. Use of Speech marks and speech bubbles.

Story writing—Structuring a letter and recount writing.

Shared Reading—Exploring Myths and legends.

Grammar - Explore verbs, nouns, adjectives, prepositions.

Sounds— igh, oy, e, u, u-e, se, le, ck.

Children will have access to Home Reads and we encourage you to read with your child each night.
