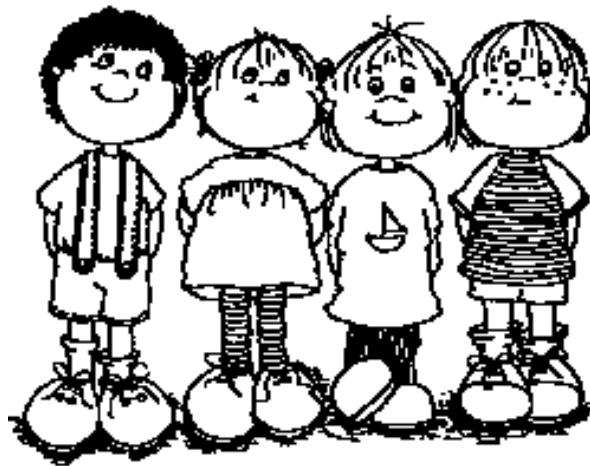


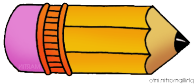

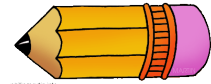


Primary 4

In Primary Four our work is now presented in topic form to tie all areas of learning together as much as possible.

This leaflet outlines what we will be covering in MaY / June in Numeracy and Literacy and through the theme of 'All at sea,' (Pirates and the Titanic), so that home learning can be organised to support your child if you wish.

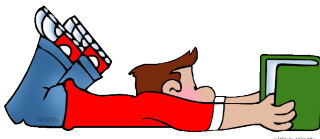
Please Note: - *Not all aspects of each subject are included in this document and all children work at different levels of ability.*

Numeracy

Number - Continue addition and subtraction of HTU (exchanging), continuation of multiplication ($\times 0$ $\times 1$ $\times 2$, $\times 3$ $\times 4$ $\times 5$ and $\times 10$). Introduction of division (dividing by 2, 3, 4, 5, 10). Use the correct notation of money, addition, subtraction and simple multiplication within £5.00.

Exploring area, angles and compass points.

Time and Measure- Continue telling the time in five minute intervals (up to the hour). Analogue and digital. Exploring capacity and length.



Literacy

Sentence Work - Detailed comprehension work. Character studies and letter writing. Continue to revise capital letters, full stops, question marks, commas and exclamation marks. Use of Speech marks and speech bubbles.

Shared Reading and grammar — Sequencing events and examining plots within text. Comparing playscripts to prose. Explore the use of nouns, verbs and adjectives.

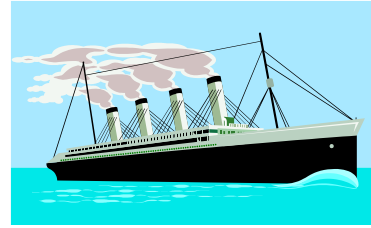
